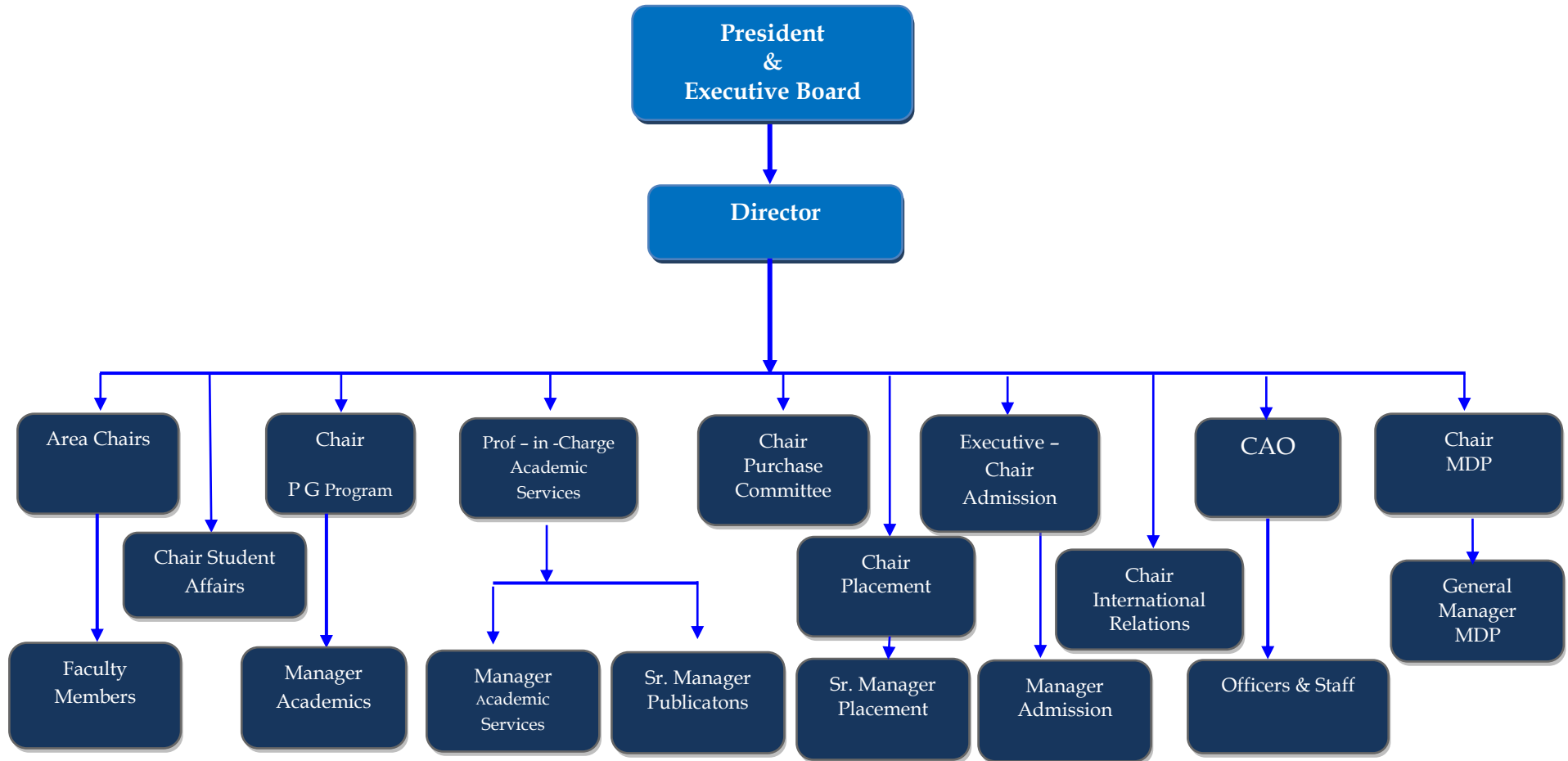

All the nodes are secured from virus, spyware/malware with Symantec Endpoint Protection, centrally monitored from the Antivirus server.
- ❖ Entire campus is fully Wi-Fi enabled with Ruckus wireless consisting of ZoneFlex 2942/7341 (802.11g) Smart Wi-Fi access points with ZoneDirector 1000 controlling the Access Points.

- ❖ Each student is allotted a mail-id besides Faculty and staff members. The mail server and web server are hosted in the computer centre itself. Facilities for printing through high speed Color/Mono Laser Jet Network printers and Scanning are available & Sun storage has been installed for back up purpose. The institute will be implementing its Campus Management System shortly.
- ❖ All the students have their mail-ids on fsm.ac.in domain. The existing mail server has been replaced with a very high end server with 2.25 TB storage capacity.

Library facilities:

FSM Library is best managed library with collection of about 29176 volumes focused on business, management and other allied subject areas. To support high quality teaching and learning, library has full text access to over five thousand of international journals through ABI-INFO-Proquest, EBSCO Business Source Elite and Sage online. The other research oriented databases viz., Gartner Research, Euromonitor International: Passport and CapitaLine Plus has been subscribed by the library which enables students and faculty to access complete statistics and reports of

Indian and International companies. Library has subscribed in print form about 108 national and international journals and magazines. Library has access to PressReader online database which delivers the instant access over 1000 world's leading newspapers and magazines from 1880 publishers from 95 countries. In addition to above, Urkund (Anti-Plagiarism online tool) have also been subscribed which helps faculty members to ensure the originality in research papers and project reports, etc., and are actively being used. Further, NVivo software has been procured to ensure and analysis the qualitative aspects of research and access of this software has been extended through campus wide network. For enriching & lively class room teaching and learning experience, library has a subscription of "The Case Center", and special arrangements with HBSP, Ivey Publishing and IIM Ahmadabad, etc. for procurement of Cases and Simulations.

The library has been providing Daily News Headlines Service. It gathers important daily news in full text on Management Education from leading procured newspapers in digital form. The daily news items gathered have been archived and provided access online since 2011. The library has been publishing monthly "Info+" (Info Plus: a monthly newsletter of FSM Library) which updates academic fraternity about the New Added Information Resources, Services and other development of the library.

Further to meet academic and research requirement, library has been subscribing the membership of National Institute of Science Communication and Information Resources (NISCAIR), New Delhi (National Science Library) and American Library. Library has an arrangement more than 5002 premier institute's libraries to share resources through Developing Library Network (DELNET). The membership of Management Libraries Network (MANLIBNET) has been subscribed for professional development and networking.

FSM library is well equipped with latest IT tools and equipments to collect, store, retrieve, and disseminate information. A number of computer systems are installed to access the library resources and services. All major functions of the library are computerized by using leading, web-enabled, multiuser, integrated library management software, which provides single-window access facility to search the library documents and user's account information at their desktop 24X7.

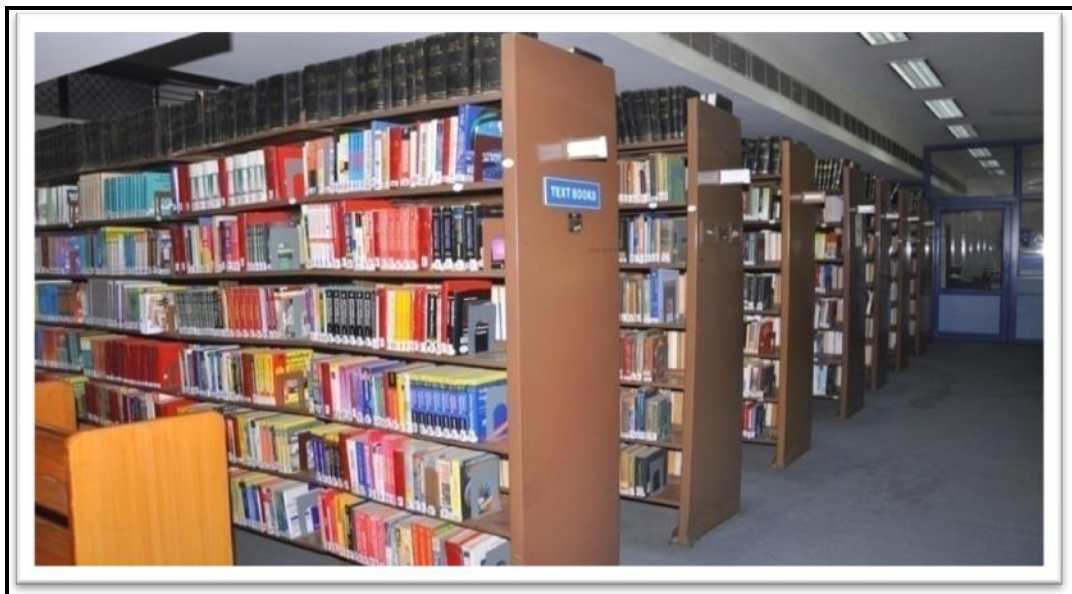
eFOREGyanSanagrah: An Institutional Digital Repository (IDR) of FORE

Boys & Girls Hostel

- ❖ FORE School of Management has coordinated with M/s Rajhans Hostels Limited located in Katwaria Sarai, at a distance of 500 Mtrs from the FORE campus with a view to facilitate the students who wish to avail the hostel accommodation. The hostel has separate floors earmarked for boys and girls and can accommodate

more than 160 students.

- ❖ Hygienic Mess facility also available in both the hostels.
- ❖ All other facilities like medical and daily needs items are available at walking distance. For medical facilities two reputed hospitals are located in the vicinity and all students are covered by Medical Insurance.

Student activities forms an integral part of the curriculum at FORE. Students are encouraged to enhance their managerial, leadership and social skills through organizing a series of student-driven events throughout the year. This gives them real-time experience of interacting with corporate and working in teams, planning and controlling budgets, managing events, time-management and developing decision-making skills. Cultural and social activities being organized by the students develop them into more mature, aware and responsible corporate citizens.

Brief descriptions of the Activities of team-wise are as under:

ANTAR' In Service to the Community:

FORE believes that students must be good citizens and play a responsible role in society. The team's activities are related to social responsibility. Some of the activities of team Antar include:

- Blood Donation Camp in association with Rotary Blood Bank, donating 100 (aprox.) unit of blood.
- '*Go Green*' Plantation Drive (Sanraskhan) in and around 20 Institutes in Qutub Institutional Area, New Delhi.
- Rice Bucket Challenge - collecting rice/pulses and handed over to NGO for distribution to the blood affected areas of our country.
- Aashayein - to motivate underprivileged children to go for schooling, in association with Salaam Balak Trust at Tees Hazari (DMRC Shelter Home), Delhi.
- Vastrasamman - collecting of clothes, articles/toys, etc. and hand over to NGO--Goonj
- Abhiwadan - to honour senior citizens of old-age homes.
- Nukkad plays (under Genesis an Annual Management Fest of FORE).

CORPORATE INTERACTION DIVISION (CID):

CID is intended to be the face of the institute to the industry. It aims at bridging the gap between the academia and the corporate world. Students organize interactive sessions to gain experiential learning through Anubhuti- a forum under the aegis of CID that regularly invites senior corporate professionals and leaders to share their practical business experiences with students.

The team also organizes Conclaves/Confluences in the area of Financial/Marketing/H.R and also organizes Kurukeshetra under Genesis (Annual Management Fest of FORE).

FORE SPORTS AND CULTURAL DIVISION (FSCD):

FSCD aims at re-energizing students during their stressful academic life at campus by organizing various sports and cultural events throughout the year. The team organize cultural programme in association with SPIC MACAY (Bharatanatyam/classical instrumental performance).

In addition to the above, FSCD team is actively involved in organizing various intra-inter sports events at FORE to inculcate sporting spirit among students., FSCD team organize cricket (Super-8) match, chess tournament, carom tournament, table tennis tournament, Gamer's Asylum V.3.5., . Moreover, the team organizes rangoli and poster making competition, etc. during Genesis.

FORE TECH:

Team FORETech provides a podium for interaction and networking among the students. The team has organized various online events including IT awareness seminars, movie making, Quizzomania, etc. The team is also responsible for designing, developing and submitting ready to display contents on LCD at FORE. Also organize events viz. Technoslides, Fast Food Hunger, etc.

NEXUS -The Cultural Committee:

Team Nexus organize annual management festival "Genesis". Students from various well known B-Schools are participating in debates, management games, case analysis, competitions, etc.

The team also organizes 'Freshers Welcome" so as to interact with the new students and help them to settle in the FORE Culture; bid Farewell to the outgoing students and wish them success for their future career.

Other activities viz. Independence Day Eve, Teachers Day, Deepawali, Constitution Day in order to respect the Nationality/Integrity and Unity.

THINK TANK:

The team THINK TANK conducts events for stimulating the intellectual capacity of the students. The team organizes various events viz. Case Study Competition, Debate, Quizzark, Tathagat, etc. In addition, events like Corporate Buddha, Amazing Race being organized by the team during Genesis.

TEDx:

TED is annual event that brings together the world's leading thinkers and doers to share ideas that matter in any discipline, be it technology, entertainment, design, science, humanities, or business development. The talks at the conference known as "TED Talks", are then made available to watch for free online on their official channel. TEDx was created in the spirit of TED's mission, "ideas worth spreading". Similar to TED, the cornerstone of TEDx is to celebrate and elevate ideas. The simplified authentic manner in which various ideas are shared leads to powerful dissemination. The events are planned independently, under a free license granted by TED.

FORE Career Division (FCD):

FORE Career Division (FCD) coordinates and manages the recruitment drive at FORE. The members manage and coordinate a plethora of activities ranging from connecting with the corporates to facilitating various industry engagement activities. The committee aims towards identifying the employee needs of the Corporate and matching them with the credentials of the students at FORE, through a series of planned process, communication and activities.

Personality Enhancement Cell:

Personality Enhancement Cell (PEC) at FORE is a student-driven Committee which was formed with the aim of grooming the students better for the placement season.

The Committee organizes Group Discussions every week for the students. All the students (1st year and 2nd year) are free to participate in the GDs on a first-come-first-serve basis. Immediately after the GDs, the participants are given feedback by the Committee members. The topics for discussion are selected after taking into consideration the topics allotted by companies during the placement process, including Intolerant India, Make in India, Start-up India, China Crisis and other important issues.

PEC also organizes weekly Newsroom sessions, which are informal news-sharing and discussion platform for the students of FORE. Team PEC acts as a facilitator to provide a platform to all the students to discuss latest issues in business, politics, economy, world affairs, etc., and helps them develop a viewpoint on every topic through discussion and debate. Certain topics discussed during the session include Greek crisis, China currency devaluation, Volkswagen fiasco, GST, Payment banks, One rank one pension, Syrian refugee crisis, Beef ban, Vodafone transfer pricing, to name a few.

The Committee even conducts mock interviews for the first year students,

wherein the placed second year students provide a platform for them to work on their resumes and answers to frequently asked questions in interviews.

FORE Alumni Network (FAN):

The FAN team is a liaison between the Institute and Alumni. It strengthens the bond of the FORE fraternity, through various activities including an interactive web-site for the alumni, an annual meet, a cricket match of alumni with current students and a number of other rendezvous activities.

Library Committee:

FORE has a student library committee which evaluates subscriptions, student suggestions and looks after the continuous value addition and up gradation of the library.

Canteen Committee:

The Canteen Committee works towards ensuring nutritious, hygienic and balanced diet at reasonable rates.
