Sub: AICTE approval to Fore School of Management, B-18, Qutab Institution Area, Saheed Jit Singh Marg, New Delhi - 110 016 for extension of approval for the academic year 2006-07.

Sir,

As per the Regulations notified by the Council vide F.No. 37-3/Legal/2004 dated 28th November 2005 and norms, standards, procedures and conditions prescribed by the Council from time to time and based on the recommendations of the Appraisal Committee/ Expert Committee, I am directed to convey the extension of approval of the Council to Fore School of Management, B-18, Qutab Institution Area, Saheed Jit Singh Marg, New Delhi - 110 016 for conduct of the following courses with the intake indicated below:-

Important Note:

- 1 It has come to the notice of the Council that several unapproved courses are being conducted by the institution (Annexure-1). The institution is advised to apply for AICTE approval for unapproved courses/ programmes in the field of Technical Education as per the regulations notified by the Council vide Notification No. F.37-3/Legal/2004 dated 28th November 2005 by 07th March 2006 or discontinue conduct of all such unapproved courses/ programmes with immediate effect, failing which this extension of approval for the year 2006-2007 stands withdrawn and further appropriate action shall be initiated against the Institution.

The above approval is subject to rectification of following observations/deficiencies/ specific conditions by 31st August 2006.

- Built up area shortfall of 17.21% (Required: 3120 sqmt., Available: 2583 sqmt.)
- The same premises is being use for MCA programme also.
- The institution runs Foreign University programmes **without having AICTE approval.**
- The institution has issued advertisement for admission to NRI/PIO category **without having AICTE approval** to admit students under this category.
- Faculty Resources (27 nos.) are being shared for PGDBM, MCA and other unapproved programmes ✓ 59
- Admission process should be made more transparent. _____ details
- The institution has not complied with the deficiencies communicated in the last approval letter. _____

The institution is required to submit 2 copies of the Compliance Report, indicating the rectification of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosure and details of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Website www.aicte.ernet.in) to the concerned Regional Office latest by 31st August 2006.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the form of demand draft in the favor of Member Secretary, AICTE, payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be entertained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiencies through surprise random inspection without any prior notice.

The approval is further subject to fulfillment of following general conditions:-

- 1 That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
2. (a) That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- (b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
