Dr. Jitendra Das, Director-FORE was a panelist in the Plenary Session 4 titled “Regulatory Policy for Developing Futuristic B-Schools in India” on the Day 2 of the event. Regulatory framework for MBA/PGDM Programmes was introduced in 1990’s which was based on the context of the business environment prevailing during pre-liberalization period. It laid too much focus on physical infrastructure and inputs to these programmes. Post-liberalization, Indian economy has radically changed from primarily a manufacturing economy to a global economy with dominance of the service sector. During 2011 to 2014, MBA/PGDM

Programmes faced a rigid regulatory regime, which underwent a major change after 2015 onwards. Looking forward to the next five years or so, there is requirement of a regulatory framework which is supportive to innovation, experimentation and entrepreneurship.
