

EPSI Round Table Discussion

“Draft National Education Policy 2019”

June 18, 2019 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi

Education Promotion Society for India (EPSI) organized a round table discussion on “Draft National Education Policy 2019”, on June 18, 2019 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi, with the objective to seek and collect views and opinion on the “Draft National Education Policy 2019” and submit to the Government. Scholars, Edupreneurs, Policy Makers, Intellectuals, Industry Leaders and Academicians across the nation had gathered to share their valuable inputs. Also present among others, were Dr Anil D. Sahasrabudhe, Chairman AICTE. He appealed all private institution heads, “not to think of the policy as a government policy, instead a policy owned by all private and government”.



Dr. Jitendra Das, Director, FORE School of Management, New Delhi was one of the speaker in the EPSI Roundtable Discussion. **Dr. Das** highlighted pressing need to have a uniform regulatory system across different categories of institutions in India and emphasised “A higher education system reform as radical as the Economic Reform of 1991, is desperately needed”.

“More than a reform policy document, this looks sort of a wish-list. Challenges and Problem areas need to be identified followed by realistic objectives clearly laid down along with implementation plans which can produce tangible results, should be included in Policy documents draft” said **Dr. Jitendra K. Das, Director, FORE School of Management**.

The valuable inputs shared by all participants will go a long way in framing the draft and making Indian education system robust, enhanced and of eminence.
