5. **LIVE PROJECT** - CSD spearheaded a baseline study for a leading NGO ETASHA Society in South Delhi. The NGO wanted to open a Skill Development Center in Sangam Vihar, New Delhi for the youth and senior citizens. The Project ‘Roopantaran’ was initiated to know about the status of skills development and employability of the youth in Sangam Vihar, New Delhi. The project also focuses on the community’s outlook and their willingness toward skills development and employment opportunities with the training programs by an NGO. It started in August 2019 and ended in January 2020.
6. **LIVE PROJECT** – CSD was approached by the Indian Federation of Culinary Associations (IFCA), New Delhi to conduct a live Research Project on “CSR and Sustainability: Chef’s Perspective”. In the first phase, CSD Team attended their 8th International Chef’s Conference on **05th October 2019** at Hotel Pullman, Aerocity, New Delhi. During the conference, the CSD Team interacted with and interviewed chefs who were attending the conference. Then in the second phase, the survey was conducted to understand the awareness level & perspective of the Chefs towards the CSR and Sustainability initiatives started by their respective hotels. All the responses gathered were analyzed and an initial project report was submitted to the Indian Federation of Culinary Associations in February 2020.
