DRONE PILOT TRAINER – JOB DESRIPTION & QUALIFICATIONS/ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A. JOB DESRIPTION & MAIN TASKS (KRAS)

Reporting to the Accountable Manager-cum-Chief Technical Officer and through him/her to the FIDTR CEO, the Drone Pilot Trainer shall perform the following tasks that will constitute his KRAs:

- 1. The trainer shall ensure that the Remote Pilot Training is conducted as per the syllabus and in compliance with the Accepted/Approved TPM.
- 2. Establish training plans for remote pilots
- 3. Develop courseware material, as required
- 4. Deliver classroom and on the job training
- 5. Issue and update the relevant documentation (training manuals)
- 6. Participate in rule making activities
- 7. Operate as remote pilot on demand
- 8. To ensure UAS operations are conducted in accordance with the extant Acts, Rules, Circulars and Guidelines.

B. Eligibilty

The Drone trainer must be a DGCA Certified Drone Trainer - the Instructor should have successfully undergone DGCA approved trainer program on the appropriate category and class of Drones.

The Drone Trainer must have knowledge of the Drone Pilot Training syllabus as prescribed by the DGCA, and procedural guidelines for classroom training, simulator training and flying (day time and night) training.
