The FORE Sports Division enriches the student experience by complementing academic excellence with dynamic sporting events. These initiatives cultivate a spirit of camaraderie, healthy competition, and community engagement. Throughout the year, we host a diverse range of indoor and outdoor activities that promote physical fitness, stress relief, and team building. We also encourage participation in inter-B-School tournaments, offering students valuable opportunities to network professionally while developing essential life skills such as discipline, perseverance, and respect. By engaging in these experiences, students enhance their holistic growth and emerge as future-ready leaders.

EVENTS -

1. **SAMAR** - SAMAR is the annual sports fest of FORE School of Management, first launched in 2023 with four sporting events. Now encompasses ten major sports - Cricket, Football, Table Tennis, Chess, Badminton, Carrom, Pool, Basketball, Throwball and Volleyball. The event provides a prestigious platform for students to demonstrate their athletic abilities while fostering camaraderie across institutions. SAMAR embodies our commitment to competitive spirit, large-scale event management, and national level engagement.
2. **Section Wars** - Section Wars is the ultimate showdown at FORE, bringing together all sections in a battle for glory. The competition showcases over 9 sports along with a cultural *Talent Hunt* that lets sections earn points by displaying their skills. With nearly 400 students participating, every section was actively engaged, making Section Wars a true celebration of talent, teamwork, and spirited rivalry.
3. **Sling N' Swing** - Sling N' Swing is FORE's flagship cricket and throwball sporting extravaganza, designed to foster sportsmanship, teamwork, and healthy competition among students. The event featured two exciting tournaments: the **Box Cricket League (BCL)** and **Fling It**.

The **Box Cricket League (BCL)** was organized in a lively 'Gully Cricket' format to encourage interaction between the batches of '26 and '27 while promoting female participation. The tournament attracted **24 registered teams and over 226 participants**, competing in a League-cum-Knockout format. The top-performing teams were recognized for their outstanding performances, while the best male and female players were awarded for their consistent excellence throughout the tournament.

Fling It, an exclusive throwball tournament for women, aimed to encourage and empower female athletes on campus. The event witnessed participation from **12 teams**

and more than 60 participants. Played in a knockout format, the tournament concluded with an exciting final, showcasing exceptional talent, determination, and competitive spirit among the participants.

4. **League of Legends** - League of Legends is a vibrant indoor sports event designed to give students a well-deserved break from the intensity of exams and campus placements. It offers a mix of engaging activities such as Arm Wrestling, Carrom, Chess, Pool, Foosball and Table Tennis, giving participants the chance to showcase their skills across multiple games. The top two players in Carrom, Chess, Foosball and Pool, along with winners across various Arm Wrestling and Table Tennis formats, were awarded for their achievements. To ensure female participation, dedicated Arm Wrestling and Table Tennis categories for women were introduced.
5. **Cricket Showdown** - The FORE Sports Division hosts **Cricket Showdown: FORE Faculty & Staff vs. FORE Students**, a thrilling contest that brings together the institution's management and student cricket players. Across three exciting matches, the event celebrates friendly rivalry, strengthened team spirit, and unites the FORE community through the shared passion for cricket.
