**Personality Enhancement Cell (PEC)**  
**AY 2025-26**

PEC organized the following activities and events in AY 2025-26.

**1. MOCK-A-THON:**

On February 01, 2026, the Personality Enhancement Cell organized a large-scale Mock Personal Interview Drive for first-year students. Over 180+ students participated in mock interviews conducted by 50+ distinguished industry professionals and alumni from leading organizations such as Google, BCG, McKinsey & Company, EY, Accenture, and Deloitte. The session provided students with valuable interview exposure, personalized feedback, and practical insights to enhance their professional preparedness.

**2. PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:**

This student-driven program commenced on 19th July 2025 and benefited 580+ students. It aims to help the first-year students connect with second-year students so that the junior batch can utilize the experience and knowledge of the senior batch for their enhanced placement performance.

**3. SEMINARS:**

- **The Retail Edge: Personality, Presence & Mantras of Success:** On July 17 and 18, 2025, PEC conducted Personality Grooming Sessions at the Gurugram and Delhi campuses. Led by Mr. Chanakya Purohit (Senior Manager – Business Development, Mokobara), the sessions focused on communication skills, professional etiquette, confidence building, and workplace readiness.
- **Acing Guesstimates:** On November 21, 2025, PEC organized a webinar for first-year students conducted by Mr. Mohd Saquib (Senior Manager, EXL). The session covered effective approaches to solving guesstimate questions commonly asked in interviews.
- **Management Consulting Careers-Why, What and How:** On January 8, 2025, PEC organized a session on Consulting Careers for students. Conducted by Mr. Sanjeev Bhalla (Group CEO, KNS), the session provided insights into career opportunities, industry expectations, and growth prospects in the consulting domain.

- **Ace the Interview:** On January 12, 2026, PEC organized a session conducted by Ms. Vrinda Gupta (Soft Skills Faculty, Physics Wallah). The session focused on interview preparation, covering key strategies for answering questions confidently and making a positive impression during interviews.
- **Mark the talk - How to Stand Out and Win the Offer:** On January 14, 2026, PEC organized a session conducted by Ms. Kavita Pasricha (Senior Corporate Trainer, 10,000 Speakers). The session focused on interview success strategies, personal branding, and techniques to help students differentiate themselves during the recruitment process.
- **Leadership Skills in an AI-Driven World:** On February 10, 2026, PEC organized a session conducted by Ms. Richa Wahi (Founder & CEO, TalesDatSpin). The session explored the evolving role of leadership in the age of AI, highlighting the importance of adaptability, strategic thinking, and human-centric skills in a technology-driven workplace.

#### 4. INDUSTRY CONNECT:

On February 27, 2026, PEC organized Industry Connect, a panel discussion for students at the Gurugram campus. The session featured Mr. Ritesh Shrivastava (CHRO, VRS Foods) and Mr. Amiya Vikram (CHRO, Axalta Coating Systems), with Prof. Chiradip Bandyopadhyay as the faculty panelist. The discussion provided valuable insights into industry expectations, leadership, and emerging workplace trends.

#### 5. GENESIS: GUILTY AS CHARGED:

On February 7, 2026, PEC organized Guilty as Charged, its annual legal mock trial simulation competition under the aegis of Genesis 2025-26. The competition was conducted in three rounds: an online quiz, followed by Vindicator's Arena, where participants defended controversial business and political personalities, and culminating in the Court of Last Appeal, a legal mock trial simulation. The top three teams were declared winners and awarded a total cash prize of ₹20,000.

## **6. MOCK PI SESSIONS:**

On October 11, 12, and 13, 2025, and January 18, 2026, PEC organized a series of Mock Personal Interview Sessions for the entire second-year batch of over 720 students. Conducted by industry professionals through Master Naukri, the sessions featured one-on-one interview simulations followed by immediate and personalized feedback. The initiative provided students with valuable interview exposure and helped enhance their placement preparedness.

## **7. MOCK GROUP DISCUSSION SESSIONS:**

- Throughout the academic year, PEC organized Mock Group Discussion Sessions for the entire second-year batch of 720 students. Conducted across 50+ sessions by industry professionals through Master Naukri and Board Infinity, the initiative provided students with a simulated group discussion experience and constructive feedback to enhance their communication, critical thinking, and placement readiness.
- Throughout the academic year, PEC conducted a series of Mock Group Discussion Sessions for first-year students. Facilitated by FORE School of Management faculty members across 10+ sessions, the sessions introduced students to group discussions as an important component of corporate hiring and placement processes. Participants received constructive feedback and early exposure to the format and evaluation criteria used during recruitment.

## **8. WORKSHOPS:**

Throughout the academic year, PEC organized about 15 placement preparation workshops for students. Conducted primarily for second-year students, with select sessions for first-year students, these workshops were facilitated by Master Naukri and Board Infinity and covered key aspects of the placement process, including:

- CV Building Workshops
- Group Discussion Workshops
- Interview Preparation Workshops
- Placement Etiquette Workshops

The sessions provided practical guidance, industry insights, and personalized feedback to help students prepare effectively for recruitment and placement processes.
