SIG-IP has organized its flagship event as a part of Genesis in the AY 2025-26 in collaboration with **FEFF**. The activities have been cited below:

Capital Quest, part of Genesis event, was an inter college competition held from January 2, 2025 to February 7, 2026. The competition attracted 295 students from prestigious business schools across the country, with a

total of 74 teams registering to participate. **Capital Quest** consisted of three rounds, with the final round being held offline on February 7, 2026. Participants were tasked with developing an in-depth analysis of the assigned company. The event challenged students' analytical and strategic skills, providing them with a platform to showcase their business acumen. The multi-road format ensured a thorough evaluation of the teams' capabilities, making it a rigorous and enriching experience for all involved.

The event saw the participation of 295 students from prestigious B-schools of the country. This year a total number of 74 teams registered for **Capital Quest**, and the event was conducted in 3 rounds on the following dates:

examples and case studies, he demonstrated how fraud schemes evolve and the importance of maintaining robust governance and compliance frameworks.

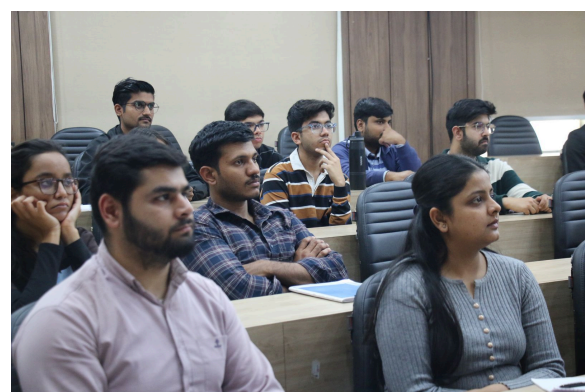
